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From our Founder

Thirty years ago, I had an idea: seeing the world by bike could be more than a vacation. It could be deeply enriching when done in a way that was unhurried, immersive, and a little luxurious—enough that you could be fully present in the moment instead of thinking about what comes next.

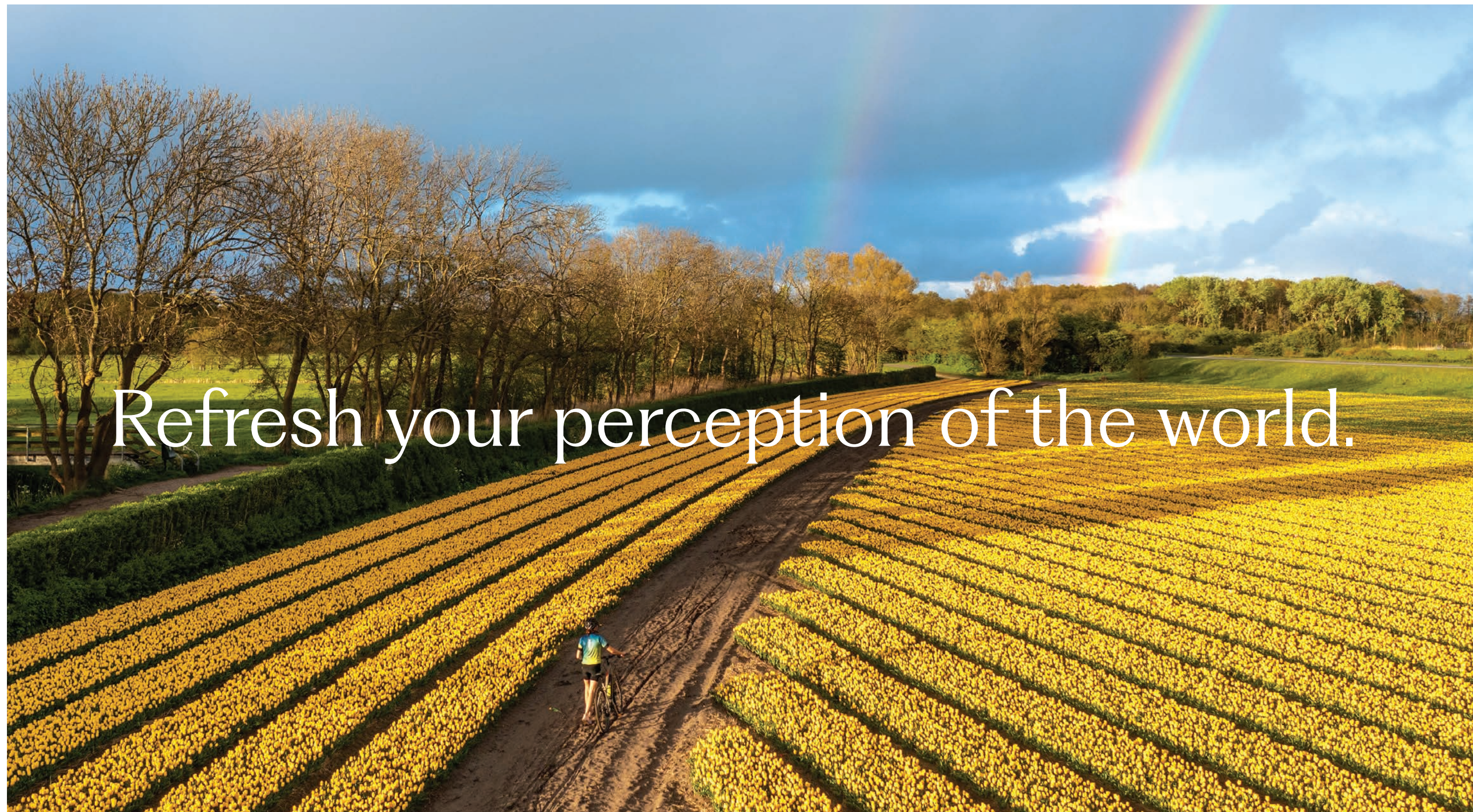
Back then, I planned routes with a paper map. I knocked on doors and relied on word-of-mouth recommendations. I talked to everyone who would listen. There were no AI trip-planning tools, no Strava to track my rides, no Google Maps to search for a nearby café, no travel influencers on Instagram. Slow travel wasn't a trend. It was just the way we traveled.

Much has changed since 1996, but one thing remains the same: I will always do what feels true to DuVine. We still design tours by striking up conversations and tapping long-held personal connections. We bypass main roads, riding instead until we find the *right* roads. We follow the simple formula we've perfected over three decades: bike, eat, drink, sleep.

In other words, the human touch is integral to our style of travel—just as it was in 1996, and as it will be in thirty years more. I hope you'll trust DuVine to lead the way forward.

Riding Levels

Our itineraries are designed to accommodate all types of travelers, from cycling newcomers to avid riders and everyone in between. Trips range from Level 1 (leisurely) to Level 4 (challenging)—often, the geography and terrain of a destination dictates the difficulty of the cycling.

Wondering where to start? The chart below should help you determine your ideal riding level. Then, as you browse this book, look for the Level  listed with each trip.

When it's time to hit the road, daily routes include longer and shorter options so you can ride the amount that's right for you. What's more, a support van is present on all tours—not only for mechanical help and refreshments, but for anyone who's ready to retire the bike and catch a lift.

One last tip: if your heart is set on a destination with tougher cycling, choosing the right bike is key. *See more on page 66*

E-Bikes

It doesn't matter if you're brand new to bike vacations or a seasoned cyclist: there are countless ways an e-bike can enhance your enjoyment in the saddle, whether that means reaching new heights or going somewhere you wouldn't otherwise go.

We think of e-bikes as the great equalizer because they make it easier to tackle climbs, ride longer distances, maintain endurance, and keep pace with the group. Whatever your reason, an e-bike lets you embrace the journey without worry.

There are two styles of e-bikes in our fleet: a Specialized e-bike that offers the upright, stable feeling of a hybrid bike, and a BMC e-bike with the handling and agility of a road bike. Both provide an extra boost to your own pedal power using a small motor—you can switch it on and off at will, so you're always in control of how much (or how little) assistance you use. *See our bikes on page 67*
